FLY ROD PINK POLLYWOG ROSE'



TASTING NOTES

This Rosé features a brilliant copper-pink color and lovely aromas of strawberries, Rainier cherries, red currants, tangerine, pink rose petals, lavender and pink incense. The flavors are vivid and nicely extracted, with notes of grape skins, cherry stones and Wahluke Slope dusty minerals. The vivacity continues on the back with sensations of fraise and cerise liqueurs and tangerine peel, followed by a pleasingly juicy dry finish.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Our grapes were hand sorted and mechanically destemmed into a small bin for a 30 minute cold soak to bring out flavors and color. About 95 gallons of pink juice was transferred to a stainless steel tank for a 15-day cool fermentation. Bottled March 2020.

VINTAGE AND VINEYARD NOTES

Overall, the 2019 growing season was slightly cooler when compared with recent years, but on par with historical 20-year averages. The result will be more age-worthy red wines and food-friendly whites and roses. Frost in October led to a frantic end to the 2019 harvest. Our Mourvedre was harvested from Weinbau vineyard on October 14 and bottled on March 20, 2020.
